The Oujda team is based in the Department of History at the Faculté des Lettres et Sciences Humaines d'Oujda, Université Mohammed I. This team has a background in ceramology and the study of traditional pottery production and its contribution will be extremely important in the knowledge of pottery making local traditions and the use of clays and experimental work on traditional techniques. This team has a Geomorphology laboratory with all the necessary facilities for analysis of sediments and soils, including clays and other materials used in pottery-making. Moreover, this team is organising a specialised laboratory for the study of traditional techniques that focuses on the use of clay for pottery and traditional architecture. At present it is involved in a Moroccan project for the study of the traditional pottery of Chefchaouen, Larache, Ourzazat and Agadir. Team members have participated in a ceramic ethnoarchaeological project in Syria with the Spanish Mission at Tell-Halula and with the Universidad de Cantabria (Spain) to study farming traditions in North-Africa
